### Courses

- Administrative Law (3 units): May 24 - June 10

  - Policy, Politics & Problem Solving (3 units): June 15 - July 1
  - Constitutional Law (3 units): July 7 - 22
  - International Human Rights Law (2 units): July 27 - August 12
- \*Courses are \$1200 per unit.

### Certificate of Specialization

- *Courses may be taken individually.*
- To receive a certificate, at least 3 courses must be taken over the summer.
- These courses are non-degree and cannot be used towards a degree program.

### Eligibility

- Applicants must have an LL.M. or J.D. degree OR
- At least 3 years experience in the public law field.
