- Constitutional Law (3 units): July 7 22
- International Human Rights Law (2 units): July 27 August 12

## **Certificate of Specialization**

- Courses may be taken individually.
- To receive a certificate, at least 3 courses must be taken over the summer.
- These courses are non-degree and cannot be used towards a degree program.

## Eligibility

- Applicants must have an LL.M. or J.D. degree OR
- At least 3 years experience in the public law field.
