FORMAT & CURRICULUM

The American Law and Language Program is a full-time, three-week intensive program. Through approximately 70 hours of instruction, participants are enriched academically and culturally through four intertwined modules:

- 1. A survey of legal English
- 2. An introduction to U.S. law and the legal system
- 3. General lectures on core legal topics
- 4. Legal research and writing workshops
